- 3) Objects of the Trust:
The objects of the trust shall be following

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- k) To develop the spiritual feelings in the public at large to reconstruct them as most responsible citizen in the society.
- l) To conduct health camps medical aid and blood donations for the needy poor and also to conduct cultural activities devotional activities such as Bhajans etc. in the village at the instance of society.
- m) To take all necessary steps to provide all facilities to protect the Gomatha's and maintain the sufficient shelter for them.
- n) To establish Goshala through trust
- o) To establish, run, develop, improve extent, grant donations, establishment, maintenance, running developing, improving place of worships, meditation centers, yoga kendras, games community centers, philanthropic centers etc., hospitals, nursing - homes, and other bodies or associations carrying similar activities.
- p) To conduct Medical camps.
- q) To undertake various Socio, Economic and Medical Activities
- r) To encourage and organize social activity to prevent the erosion of moral and ethical standards of the society
- s) To establish and maintain Educational and research institutions
- t) To conduct seminars, symposia conferences and Guest lecturers
- u) To publish or subsidize publications of relevant works, periodicals, research papers, etc.,
- v) To act as trust board, to accept endowments, bequests, donations, subscriptions, grants from institutions, both public and private, cooperative bodies, state and central governments, individuals, and administering them on terms agreed to.
- w) To carry on activities for other charitable purposes and activities of general public utility.
- x) To sanction loans and scholarships to the meritorious poor students and fellowships to Research Scholars:
- y) The above objects are independent of each other and the board of trustees hereinafter constitute, impose, from time to time and apply the funds of the trust in carrying out all or any of the aforesaid objects of the trust.
- z) To provide Old Age Homes, Handicapped and Orphans homes
To provide young women and young men who are majors from our trust are married and will be given a Marriage certificate.
- a) The above objects are independent of each other and the Board of Trustees hereinafter constitute, impose, from time to time and apply the funds of the trust in carrying out all or any of aforesaid objects of the trust.

5) POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE TRUSTEES:

- a) To accept any gifts, donations, endowments or property or money with such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Donor or Donors (but so as not to incur any liability on the part of the Trustees) in furtherance of all or any of the objects of the Trust.
- b) To build up the corpus out of the amount donated or use the said donation for any other purposes which they deem fit.

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- c) To convert any portion of the Trust estates or funds for such periods as the Trustees may think proper and to invest the proceeds in the modes and forms specified under the provisions of the Income Tax Act, as they may think proper any moneys or properties donated or given to the Trustees upon trust at any time, which is not immediately required by them for any of the purpose aforesaid and the said Trustees shall be entitled at their discretion to vary any such investment and to invest the funds of the trust in the manner stated above.
- d) To borrow or raise money by mortgage or otherwise in such manner and on such securities as the Trustees might decide upon from time to time for carrying on the objects and purposes of the Trusts and also the managing trustee is exclusively authorized to deal and to sign with the concerned on behalf of all the members of the trust and the same shall be placed in the consecutive meeting for the notice of the trust members.
- 5. To incorporate with itself any institution or association or Trust having objects wholly similar to those of the Trust and to co-operative with any person or body of persons in aid of such objects.
- 6. To do all such other lawful acts as may be necessary or incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects or any of them.
- 7. A trustee shall be at liberty at all times to retire from the Trust and shall be disqualified to hold office if he becomes or is declared to be an insolvent or to be of unsound mind, whether or not found by inquisition or shall otherwise become unfit or incapable to act or resign the Trusteeship
- 8. If the said Trustees or any one of them or any Trustee or Trustees appointed as hereinafter provided shall die or desire to retire or refuse to act or become or be declared as insolvent or become of unsound mind as stated above, it shall be lawful for the surviving or continuing Trustees or Trustee or appoint a new Trustee or Trustees in the place of the Trustee or Trustees dying or desiring to retire or refusing to act or becoming or being declared an insolvent or become or to be of unsound mind as stated above, thereupon the Trust premises and other Trust estates for the time being shall be deemed to have been conveyed or transferred to such persons or persons so succeeding to the Trusteeship so that they may be vested in him/her or them upon trust or these present and they shall have the same powers authorities and discretions in all respects as if he/she or they have been originally appointed as Trustee or Trustees by these presents and no fresh conveyance will be necessary or required in order to vest the properties in such Trustee or Trustees.

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9. The number of Trustees shall be not less than five and not more than nine. The existing or continuing Trustees shall have the power of appointing further or additional Trustees within the number prescribed above, either in the place of those retiring or becoming disqualified to hold office or as new Trustees. The new Trustees (other than the life trustees) shall hold their office for a period of two years from the date of their appointment.
10. **"SRI SAI GANAPATHI GAJANANA MANDALI AND SAINAGAR, BALASAMUDRAM DEVELOPING AND WELFARE TRUST"** is hereby appointed as Managing Trustee, to exercise all such functions of the trustees as may be delegated to him from time to time by all the other trustees. He shall hold the office for a period of three years from the date of this deed. In case of any vacancy that may arise for any of the reasons such vacancy shall be filled by all the trustees with a majority vote, from and amongst the life trustees.
11. Subject to such rules as may from time to time be framed by the Trustees, the affairs of the Trust shall be conducted and its objects carried out and the institute or institutions under this control managed by a persons to be nominated by the Trustees who may if the Trustees choose to so decide be assisted by an Advisory committee consisting of such representatives elected or nominated by the Trustees under such rules as may from time to time be framed by or under the discretion of the said Trustees and such powers may be given to the advisory committee, as the Trustees may think proper and the Trustees shall be entitled to frame, alter an add to, delete or amend any of the rules and regulations governing the Trust from time to time as occasion may arise.
12. If at any time it shall appear to the Trustees that the objects of the Trust cannot be properly or successfully carried out and the application of the Trust estate and fund will be more useful and conducive to greater good, then it shall be lawful for them if they so desire to apply the trust funds to such purpose or purposes within India as may be thought proper and to accumulate either wholly or partly the Trust Capital Fund and income thereof till such time as may be deemed necessary by the Trustees.
13. Provided that no one individual Trustee shall be liable for any breach of trust committed by his co-trustee or co-trustees or otherwise and as individual Trustees shall only be liable or answerable for his own act and in respect of any Trust property that he has actually received, it being the intention that a Trustee shall not be liable for the acts of and commissions of his co-trustees simply because he is Trustee.
14. The Trustees shall cause to be kept proper books of account with respect of all such moneys received and expended by the Trust and of all assets and liabilities of the Trust and have the same examined by one or more persons qualified to act as Auditors of Companies under the companies Act. The accounting year shall be the financial year.

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15. The trustees shall have power to frame by-laws and /or rules, alter, vary, amend, delete and add by-laws or rules for the carrying out of the objects and purpose of the Trust, with 2/3rd majority of the total member of trustees.
- 6) The income and property of the trust however derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects and purposes set forth above and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of profits to the Trustees or any other Donor provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith by the Trustees any reasonable or proper remuneration to any officers or servants or any other person employed by the Trust in return for any services actually rendered in carrying out or during the course of carrying out the objects of the Trust or in the performance of duties such as auditors, legal advisers, consultants.
- 7) The funds and properties of the Trust shall be the sum of Rs.1116/- made over to the Trust by the Author and all and every other monies and properties gifted. Conveyed and transferred to the Trustees for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the trust hereby created and all or any income derived from the said sum of Rs.1116/- additions, accretions, augmentations to the aforesaid sum.
- 8) In the event of the Trust not being able to function in fulfillment of its objects, the Trustees shall after discharging all liabilities, transfer the remaining assets of the trust to any other public charitable institution or institutions having similar objects and registered with the Commissioner of Income tax under section 12A of the Income tax Act.
- 9) Any of the terms or terms of this Trust Deed may be amended, altered abandoned or otherwise be dealt with by a decision of the majority of the trustees and after obtaining the permission of the Commissioner of Income tax having jurisdiction over the Trust.
- 10) It is hereby declared that the trust herein made is irrevocable.
- 11) No immovable property is involved by this trust deed.

VOTING RIGHTS

- 12) All members of the trust shall have equal right to vote in all matters of the trust that come for action in the Meeting or the trustees.

RESIGNATION

- 13) A Trustee may resign in writing at any time subject to any liability or obligation incurred by him while he was a Trustee. He shall cease to have any interest in the property of the trust or exercise any rights in respect thereto immediately after submission of resignation by him in writing to the Managing Trustee, and duly accepted by the Board of Trustee.

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MEETINGS

14) The Managing Trustee calls for a meeting of all the Members of Trust the said meetings shall be held once in every quarter of a year. The said Meetings shall be presided over by the Managing Trustee in the said meetings the following business shall be transacted.

- a) Resolves the policies and programmes of the trust
- b) Approves the budget and expenditure after due audit
- c) Appoints employees to execute the policies and programmes of the trust
- d) Amends the constitution of the trust as and when it is warranted
- e) Admits and withdraws the members of the trust, as per requests
- f) Appoints advisory committees and its members with a scope of their work and period of execution.

The date time and location of the Members a committee meeting shall be determined by the Chairman of the General Body.

QUORUM

15) A quorum of meeting of the trustees shall be atleast 2/3 of the total number of trustees eligible to vote

ACTION BY MEMBERS

16) If a quorum is present, the affirmative vote of a simple majority of the members shall be the action of the members.

17) A person shall cease to be a trustee in any of the following events.

- a) On his death
- b) On his resignations, becoming insolvent

18) A resolution in writing circulated amongst all the Trustees of the trust and passed by a majority of the Trustees shall be as valid and effective as is had been passed at a meeting of the Trustees.

19) The minutes of the proceedings of every meeting of the Trustees, Advisory Committee, shall be entered in a book to be kept for that purpose and signed and it will be conclusive evidence of the business and other matters conducted at such meetings.

20) The trust may open such current, savings bank and deposit accounts in the name of the trust with such bank or banks, as the Trustees may from time to time decide in this regard. And the said accounts shall be operated upon jointly by Founder & Hon'ble President :

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- 21) The Managing Trustee and such other trustees as may be authorized for this purpose shall maintain or get maintained a true and correct account of all monies received and spent in any manner for the purposes of the Trust and such account or accounts with balance sheets prepared every year shall be examined audited and certified by a qualified Chartered Accountant.
- 22) The board of Trustees shall have the right to provide for the allocation of the responsibilities regarding management of the Trust between members of Board of Trustees and to appoint sub-committees and to make rules and regulations in this behalf from time to time, as they deem fit.
- 23) The Board of Trustees may also take up the management of any other institution or institutions whose objects, fully or in part, are similar to those of this trust, and may manage and run such institutions.
- 24) The receipts, issued by the members of the board of trustees for any monies, stocks, funds shares securities or investments paid, delivered or transferred to them in execution.
- 25) The members of trust shall be respectively chargeable only for such monies, stocks, shares, funds and securities, as they shall actually receive notwithstanding their respectively signing a receipt jointly with others for the sake of the conformity and shall be answerable and accountable only for their own accounts, receipts, Neglects and others, which shall happen through their willful default or negligence respectively.
- 26) The Board of Trustees shall have full powers and discretion to award scholarships, prizes, rewards, honorarium, maintenance etc., to any person or persons they consider deserving and to remunerate authors, scholars, compiler, translators, journalists, editors, artists, workers or the ex-workers of the Trust or the departments of such persons.
- 27) The members of the Board Trustees may reimburse themselves and pay discharge out of their duties under these present.
- 28) The Board of Trustees may accept any donations or contribution in cash or by way of any property movable or immovable, from person or persons, firms, bodies, body corporate or incorporate or from Central or State Governments for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust or for anyone or more of them as they may in their discretion think fit.
- 29) The Board of Trustees may purchaser or take on lease/ licence/ agreement basis or in any other manner, both movable and immovable properties for the Trust, at any time as they think fit.
- 30) The Board of Trustees may, by a resolution, invest the surplus funds. The surplus funds of the Trust shall be invested in accordance with the provisions of Section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

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- 31) The Board of Trustees may by a resolution invest the surplus funds. The surplus funds of the Trust shall be invested in accordance with the provisions of Section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- 32) The Board of Trustees may lease out the immovable property properties as are hereafter acquired in any manner for the time being and from time to time, belonging to Trust, either from year to year, or from any lesser, or for any terms of years or on monthly tenancies on such rent, and subject to such conditions and terms as they may think proper and also accept, surrender of leases and tenancies and generally manage the same, in such manner as they think proper.
- 33) The Board of Trustees may pay all the charges payable in respect of any immovable property acquired hereafter for the time being forming part of the trust fund and may carry out repairs required to be done to the same and keep the same insured against loss or damages and may incur all other costs, charges and expenses of and incidental to the administration and management of the Trust estate and the property for the time being belonging the Trust, as they, in their absolute discretion, think fit.
- 34) The board of trustees may with the consent of the Majority of the Members raise or borrow money required for the purpose of the trust, on a mortgage of by the pledge of the Trust properties or any part thereof, with or without any securities at such rate of interest and on such terms as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
- 35) The Board of Trustees may with the consent of the majority of the members sell the whole or any part of the movable or immovable properties forming part of the Trust fund either by publication or by private contract at such price or prices and on such terms and conditions relating to the title or otherwise in all respects as they may in their absolute discretion, think fit and receive or vary any contract, for the sale thereof and for that purpose to execute all and necessary conveyance, transfers or other assurances and to pass valid and an effectual receipts and discharges for all monies received by them.
- 36) No part of the net earnings of the trust shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, officers, or other private persons except that the trust shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered or expenses otherwise incurred and to make payments in furtherance of the purpose set forth in Article-3 thereof.
- 37) The Board of Trustees may delegate any of their powers to any of their powers to any person or to a committee consisting of such persons or person whether members of their body or not, as they think fit.
- 38) The Board of Trustees may frame schemes and rules and regulations for the opening of accounts of a bank or banks and to provide for their operation from time to time, as they deem necessary.

- 40) The Board of Trustees shall have full power to compromise or compound all differences and disputes, touching the Trust-estates or Trust properties, and to refer any such differences or disputes for arbitration and to adjust and settle all accounts relating to the trust estates and trust properties and to do all other acts and things, as they are absolutely entitled to the Trust estates and Trust properties.
- 41) All decisions of the Board of Trustees shall be taken to simple majority either in the meeting or by circulation.
- 42) In the event of the dissolution of the trust for any reasons whatsoever, wall the funds and assets that are remaining after full satisfaction of all liabilities shall be paid or transferred to any other trust, organization or institution having similar object and which was registered U/s.12-A of the Income Tax Act 1961 and shall not repugnant to the provisions of the Section 80-G of the Income Tax Act.
- 43) The aims and objects of the Trust as set forth in object of the Trust as set forth in objects clause may be amended, extended or on a proposal and approval from the Board of Trustees, however, that any such alterations, modifications or amendments shall not have the effect of violating provisions of Trust Act or Section 80-G of the Income Tax Act or any statutory modifications thereof for the time being in force, and prior approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax shall be obtained.
- 44) All the acts and things of all the members of this trust shall be done for the benefit and for the development of the Trust on free of cost and no Individual out of the Trust monies and / or properties.
